## Emailing Service

In the coming term we are going to trial an email service to parents. This would enable us to send all manners of letters/communications, newsletters etc directly to you.

To start this process we need at least 1 viable email address. Please complete the attached slip and return it to school as soon as possible.

## Medicines in School

We are happy to administer medicine if your child is on a **prescribed** course. All medicine should be brought to the school office by an adult where the medicine will be stored correctly and the adult will be asked to complete a permission slip. Medicines should be collected by an adult from the office at the end of the school day.

Unfortunately we can't administer unprescribed medicine but are happy for carers/parents to come along to school to administer if needed.

**Under no circumstances should children bring medicines/painkillers into school and have them in their school bag.**

## School Photographer

We have a photographer coming into school on the morning of **Tuesday 19th May**. All children will have a single and family photograph taken. Reception and Year 6 also have a group photograph taken. If you would like a preschool child to be included on the family photo, please come to the school hall at **8.45am**.

## Tummy Bugs

Guidelines from the Health Protection Agency state that if your child experiences vomiting or diarrhoea they should remain away from school for 48 hrs from the last episode.

If your child has an isolated bout that may have been caused by eating something they may return after 24 hrs as long as they are well.

## Dinner Money/Breakfast Club Envelopes

Can we ask that all monies sent into school are given to your child to take into their class, and not to the Reception/office, (baskets are in every classroom for this purpose) in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, and what the money is for. We have purpose made envelopes for dinner money (Pink) and Breakfast club (Yellow) and these are available from the school office.

The correct amount of money would be greatly appreciated.

## Latecomers

All children should be on the yard ready to line up with their class before the bell rings at 8.55am. If your child is late they must come to the main entrance to gain access. The reason and the amount of time your child is late is recorded. Latecomers do disrupt the start of the school day. The Education Welfare Officer has access to our records and may contact persistent latecomers.
