Maths

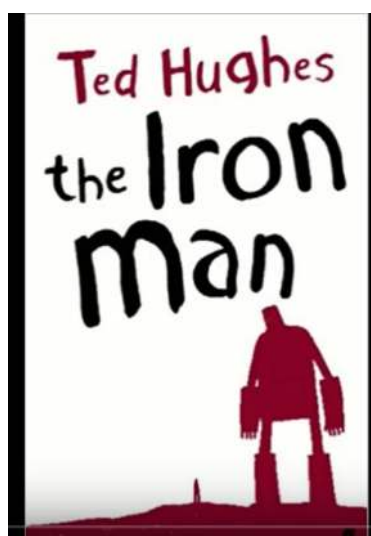
