What does it mean for staff at our school?

All staff have the right to transfer their employment under TUPE legislation from their current employer, the Governing Body, to Bishop Chadwick Catholic Education Trust. We are also keeping staff updated and offering reassurance that terms and conditions will remain in line with nationally and locally agreed pay and conditions as approved by the Bishop.

How will it affect my child's education?

Each school and Bishop Chadwick Catholic Education Trust are wholly committed to ensuring that every pupil achieves his or her full potential. We are also wholly committed to improving the quality of teaching and learning and providing staff with the best professional development. By working in collaboration with other schools within the Trust we will be able to benefit the pupils at each school by sharing resources and expertise.

Will there be any curriculum changes?

What will happen to the uniform?

Will the name of the school change?
