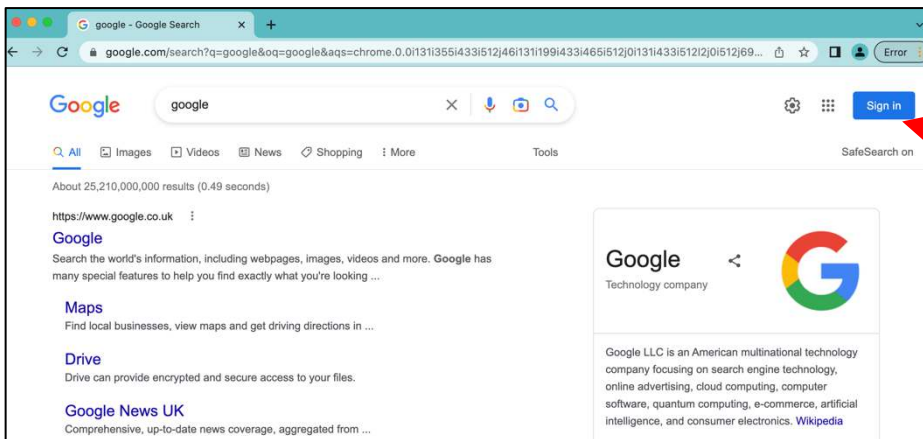
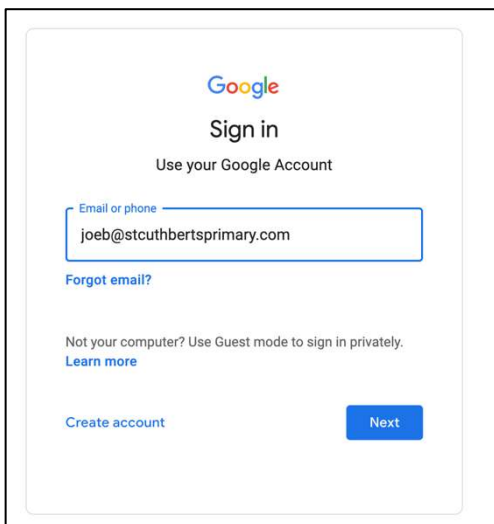


# Accessing Google Classroom at Home



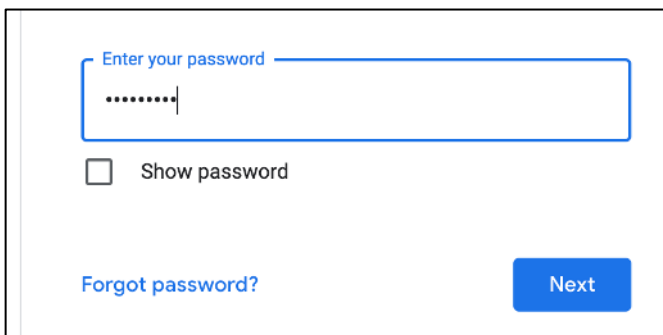

in box

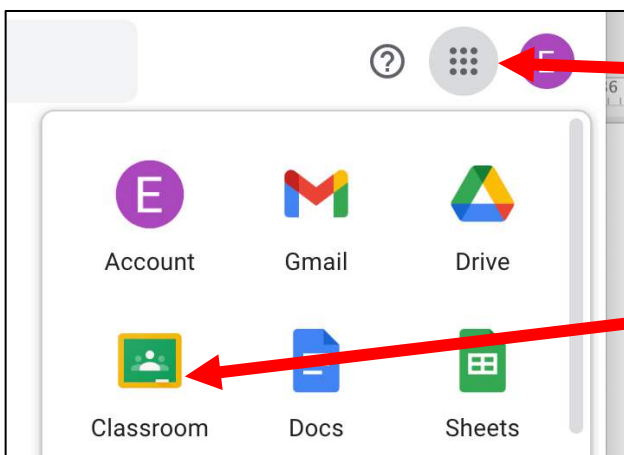


Your child's log in will be their first name

by @stcuthbertsprimary.com

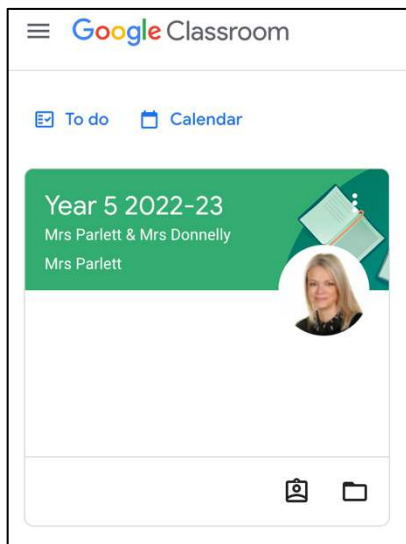

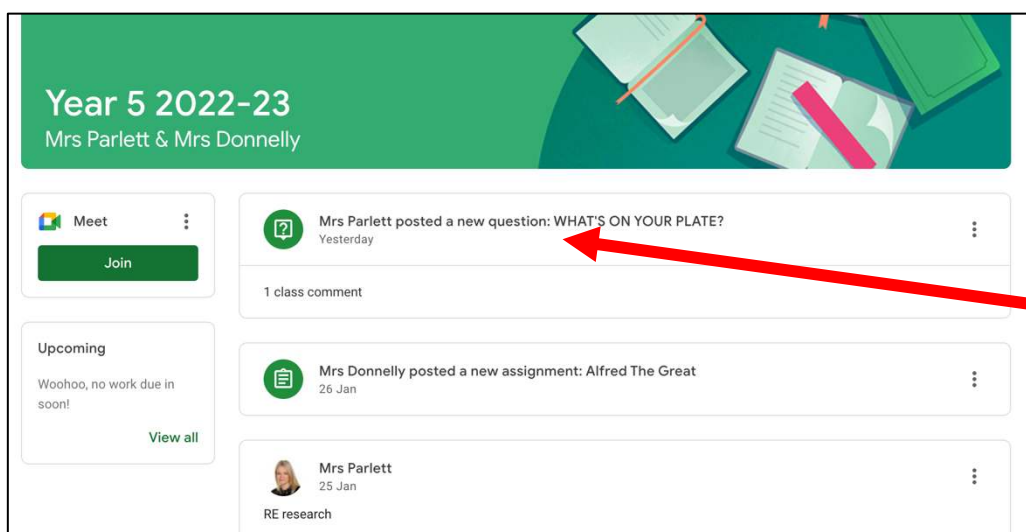
Your child should know their

tree1234. If this doesn't work  
then contact your child's class  
teacher.



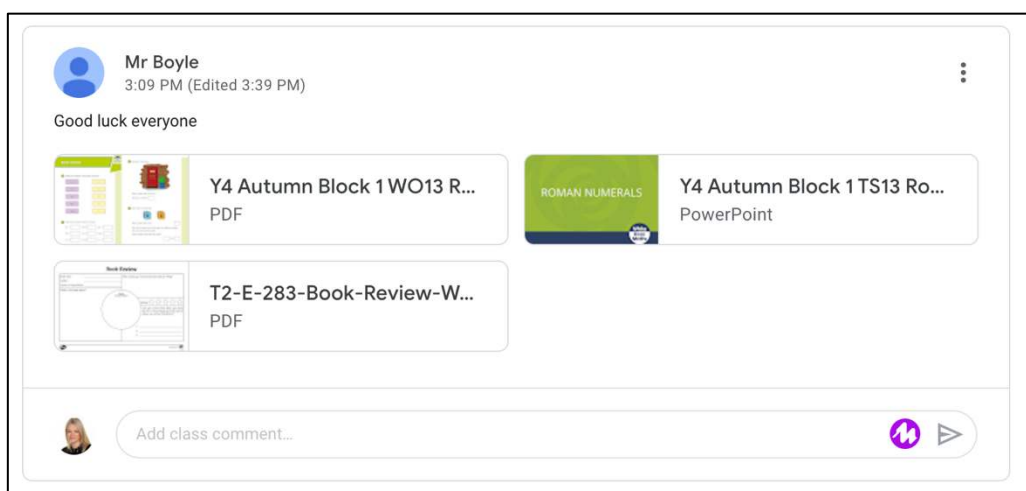
Once logged in, click the waffle  
at the top right corner of the  
screen then click Classroom.



Select your child's class by clicking the green box. If this asks for a class code, check that you are logged in correctly to Google – sometimes if more than one user accesses a device, this can cause a conflict.



Assignments appear as questions or assignments – click the text to look at details.



Sometimes there will be PDF documents to click and print.

Google Classroom is also available as an app on Android and Apple phones and devices – use the same login details.
