Curriculum

Reading

Children will read with us at school during the week, make sure they have their books daily.

Their reading books will be changed once they have finished a book and can fluently read it.

Please read with them as much as possible and record it in their log.

Phonics and spellings

- · Children will receive daily phonics lessons.
- We will be doing a mock test in November with them and spring term to ensure they're on track to pass their phonics.
- Their spellings will link to their new sound for the
 week and be sent home in their spelling book. Once
 every few weeks they will receive a spelling list
 following a 'rule' ie. +s/es to words, this will come
 with a worksheet in their spelling homework book.

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Homework Expectations

- Monday Spellings will be sent home for a test on Friday. Spelling Shed can be
 used for practicing their words for their test. The spelling list has started with 5
 spellings this week but we will build upon that as we move forward.
- Maths.com will be set on a Tuesday for the following Tuesday. Homework will be related to previous weeks maths.
- Occasionally some topic homework may be given

Homework will not be set over school holidays.

Autumn term

We will visit our local high street to link to our history topic of 'shops'- we will use public transport for this visit.

Summer term- Trip to a local nature reserve linking to their topic of plants.




Holidays and absence

Safeguarding


- Information about safeguarding pupils is on our website
